Stones have the effect of softening the material without compromising the strength and integrity of the wires. the result? A softer feel and subtle shine. Lightweight vs Heavyweight Thread counting is not the only way to measure linen quality. Many companies prefer to use GSM or grams per square meter. This is a measure of thickness, so sheets with a higher GSM (between 150 and 180) typically last longer and feel heavier than with lower GSM. Thicker sheets are not necessarily rougher, but at first they may look stiff. Fortunately, the linen softens over time with use and more washes. Fit Check the size of each brand to ensure a suitable fit for your mattress. Sizing is standard for linen sheets: from twin to king of California. However, not all brands offer all sizes, so make sure double-check the sizing and measurements, especially if you have an extra-long or extra-deep mattress. Some brands offer deep-pocket mounted sheets, measuring 15 to 22 inches deep, in contrast to the typical measurement of regular mounted sheets from 7 to 14 inches deep.
